*PAS reserves the right to make adjustments to the floor plan at any time. Completed booth reservations received by PAS prior to March 26 will be date stamped March 31, 2010. This provides a mail service grace period and affords exhibitors an opportunity to submit their down payments and agreements by this first deadline. **On March 31, these agreements will be sorted into a priority list based on each company's first year of exhibiting at PASIC. After March 31, agreements will be processed on a first-come, first-served basis.** In the case of two or more companies with the same "first year at PASIC" a lottery will determine the positions. Booths will be assigned in July to all exhibitors who have paid in full. If the balance due is not paid in full by July 2, 2010, if there are advertising bills that are more than 60 days overdue, or if the Sustaining Membership dues are not current, the exhibitor's booth will not be assigned. Please note that after July 2, 2010 booths are assigned each day to all who are paid in full. No refunds will be made on cancellations received after October 2, 2010 (see cancellation policy on page 15 for further details).
