

2012 SOLO MARIMBA COMPETITION

Materials must be postmarked by May 1, 2012

PURPOSE: To encourage the highest level of artistic expression in the art of performance and literature for solo marimba at the collegiate level. Entrants must be college level students, who are current PAS members, 18-25 years of age at the time of entry.

AWARDS: Four finalists will be selected to compete at PASIC 2012 (Oct. 31–Nov. 3) in Austin, TX. The contest will include cash awards for the finalists. Selected finalists will have their PASIC registration waived and are responsible for all other financial commitments (room, board, travel).

First Place: \$1,000
Second Place: \$750

Third Place: \$500
Fourth Place: \$250

PROCEDURES: Competition entrants must include the completed application (found at www.pas.org) and a performance DVD. Selections on the DVD must be from the repertoire listed below. The first selection must be the required composition, the second selection must be an entire piece from Category I, and the third selection must be an entire piece from Category II. Multi-movement works must be recorded in their entirety without edits. Disqualification will occur if the selections are not recorded in their entirety, the repertoire included is not from the required list as stated below, or selections have been electronically altered or edited. Follow DVD submission guidelines below.

REQUIRED COMPOSITION: Prelude & Fugue No. 21 in B-flat Major, from The Well-Tempered Clavier Book 1, BWV 866 by JS Bach

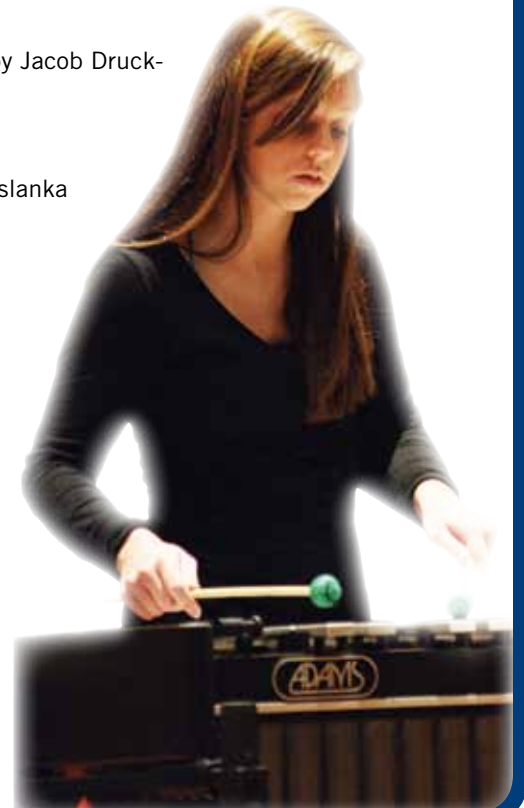
*DVD SUBMISSION GUIDELINES:

Application will immediately be discarded if DVD video format does not follow these guidelines. Formats accepted: mp4, 3g2, 3gp, 3gp2, 3gpp, asf, asx, divx, mts, m2t, m2ts, m2v, m4v, mkv, mov, mpe, mpeg, mpg, ogg, wmv.

Video resolution:

640x480 for standard definition, 4:3 video; 853x480 for widescreen DV
1280x720 for high definition.

DVD should be clearly marked with applicant's name, age and selected repertoire.
